Public Notice of Manual Audit

January 9, 2025

State law¹ requires that election officials manually audit a sample of voted ballots. This audit must be performed after each general election.

The Caroline County Board of Elections will conduct the manual ballot audit of the 2024 General Election starting on Thursday, January 30, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. This audit may take two days to complete and will take place at the Caroline County Board of Elections, located at 403 S. 7th Street, Denton, MD 21629. The audit is open to the public.

The Caroline County Board of Elections will manually tally a sample of votes cast for U.S. Senator and compare the results of the manual tally against the results from the voting system. This process will determine whether the voting system accurately counted ballots during the 2024 General Election.²

The State Board of Elections randomly selected the early voting center and election day vote center to be audited, and the Caroline County Board of Elections randomly selected the mail in and provisional ballots to be audited. Starting on January 30, 2025, the Caroline County Board of Elections will manually tally the votes for U.S. Senator on:

1. 574 ballots cast on one scanning unit on the 1st day of early voting at the Caroline County Health & Public Services Building
2. 1,127 ballots cast on election day in Precinct 007-001
3. 37 mail in ballots
4. 15 provisional ballots

² Before the 2024 General Election was certified, the State Board of Elections conducted an automated audit of **all** of the ballots cast in the 2024 General Election. The results of this audit confirmed the accuracy of the voting system. The results of the automated audit are at:
